BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), in that adopting a Resolution approving the Facility Use Agreement attached hereto does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and if a "project," is exempt under the "common sense" exception (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3)) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. That the one year Facility Use Agreement between the City of Watsonville and Community Bridges, a corporation, for the use of City owned property located at 114 East Fifth Street, Watsonville, (Watsonville Senior Center) for providing free services to senior residents aged 50 and older, commencing on July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, a copy of which Facility Use Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is fair and equitable and is hereby ratified and approved.
