## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE ACCEPTING THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE 2022 PUBLIC HEALTH GOALS REPORT (2019-2021)

WHEREAS, the City publishes its annual Water Quality Report (also referred to as the Consumer Confidence Report), summarizing all of the drinking water sampling and monitoring conducted during the previous year; and

WHEREAS, every three years, water agencies serving more than 10,000 service connections are required by Health and Safety Code Section 116470 to report if the agency has detected one or more constituents in drinking water that exceed a Public Health Goal; and

WHEREAS, agencies must hold a public hearing to accept and respond to public comments on the Public Health Goals Report, in compliance with Health and Safety Code Section 116470 (b) and (c).

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), in that adopting a Resolution amending a contract does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and if a "project," is exempt under the "common sense" exception (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3)) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment.

- The public hearing required by Health and Safety Code Section 116470(b) and (c) was held on July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022, in the City Council Chambers, during the regularly scheduled City Council meeting.
- That the City Council hereby accepts the 2022 Public Health Goals Report (2019-2021), a copy of which report is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, pursuant to the Health and Safety Code Section 116470 (b) and (c).
