A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND CALLING FOR BIDS FOR THE AMESTI WATER RESERVOIR INTERIOR COATING AND CONNECTION MODIFICATIONS, PROJECT, NO. WA-22-14826 (ESTIMATED COST OF \$825,000 WILL BE FUNDED FROM THE WATER ENTERPRISE FUND)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. In accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), this action of adopting a Resolution approving plans and specifications and calling for bids for the Amesti Water Reservoir Interior Coating & Connection Modifications Project does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and if a "project," is exempt under the "common sense" exception (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3)) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment.

2. That the plans and specifications for the Amesti Water Reservoir Interior Coating and Connection Modifications, Project No. WA-22-14826, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, are hereby ratified and approved.

3. That the Purchasing Officer is hereby authorized and directed to call for public competitive sealed bids for the above named project, and that the bids are to be opened in the "Old City Council Chambers," 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, on Wednesday, January 18, 2023, at 2:00 P.M., and the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice inviting such sealed bids in the time, form, and manner provided by law.

4. That hand-carried bids should be delivered to the City of Watsonville, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, c/o Purchasing Officer. Bidders may mail bids at their own risk to the City of Watsonville, c/o Purchasing Officer, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California 95076.

5. That after the bids are opened, they shall be tabulated and analyzed and a report submitted to the City Manager, who shall recommend the awarding, or other action, to the Council at its next regular meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible.
