In answering Member García, Community Development Director Merriam stated one of the Planning Commissioners voted against recommending revisions to sign-related sections of the Municipal Code to Council to allow additional time for public input.

Associate Planner Carmona, in answering Member García, spoke about special use permits that could be issued for signs outside the standards that would be established by the proposed ordinances.

In answering Mayor Parker, Associate Planner Carmona stated the sign ordinance had not been updated since its adoption in 1968.

Associate Planner Carmona, in answering Mayor Parker, stated existing digital signs in use by schools would be allowed to remain, but a special use permit would be required for new signs.

Member Hurst spoke in support of the revisions.

In answering Mayor Parker, Associate Planner Carmona stated portable signs would be allowed under the proposed ordinances as long as they were located on private property. He added signs painted on buildings would not be allowed unless they were previously existing.

Community Development Director Merriam, in answering Mayor Parker, stated the current ordinance did not have provisions for special use permits. She added that those permits could allow for flexibility with certain signs.
