A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT WITH PAJARO VALLEY PREVENTION AND STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, A CORPORATION, ADDING TO THE SCOPE OF WORK, ADDING TO THE COMPENSATION (INCREASING THE CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$63,000) AND EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023, TO SUPPORT COLLABORATIVE PLANNING . CAPACITY BUILDING, STRATEGIC **PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT** IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MULTI-DISCIPLINARY CRITICAL INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAM, APPROPRIATING \$63,000, FROM THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH JUSTICE INTERVENTION SERVICES GRANT TO APPLY TOWARDS AMENDED CONTRACT; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 71-22 (CM) approving a Contract with Pájaro Valley Prevention and Student Assistance Program, to support the collaborative planning, capacity building, strategic program development and implementation of the Trauma Informed Multi-Disciplinary Critical Incident Response Team (MDT) in an amount of \$160,327; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to the Contract will add to the scope of work, increase the contract amount by \$63,000 (from \$160,627 to \$223,327) and extend the term of the contract to December 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Adopting a Resolution approving a First Contract Amendment with Pájaro Valley Prevention and Student Assistance Program does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project", because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

2. The First Amendment to Contract between the City of Watsonville and Pájaro Valley Prevention and Student Assistance Program, a corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville, with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.

4. That the budget appropriation of \$63,000 from the Behavioral Health Justice Intervention Services Grant (0260) is hereby authorized.
