SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION FOR A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE

OF A DUMP TRUCK FROM RUSH TRUCK CENTERS FOR THE WATER SERVICES DIVISION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$37,202.55

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing a Change Order for the purchase of a 2023 Peterbilt, 10-yard capacity dump truck from Rush Truck Centers; a member of Sourcewell, Formerly NJPA, Contract No. 060920-PMC.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Water Services Division needs to replace a 20-year-old Volvo dump truck that has surpassed its useful life. Water Services routinely transports various heavy construction materials so it is essential that the division have a functioning vehicle.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

On March 29, 2022, City Council adopted Resolution No. 56-22 authorizing the purchase of a 2023 Peterbilt, 10-yard capacity dump truck from Rush Truck Centers in the amount of \$256,315.71. Unfortunately, during the approval process the vendor increased pricing due to inflation and demands of the vehicle industry. The vendor cannot honor the original pricing given to the City and the new purchase price has increased to \$293,518.26.

The Division needs to replace the current 1995 Volvo dump truck as it will not pass future inspections, due to wear and tear. For example, the truck's particulate filtration system is not in compliance with California Air Resources Board (CARB).
