A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND TEAMDYNAMIX, A CORPORATION, AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND ADDING TO THE COMPENSATION (INCREASING THE CONTRACT BY \$182,638.98) FOR SOFTWARE AS A SERVICE FOR A FIVE YEAR TERM; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on or about September 15, 2022, the City and TeamDynamix, a corporation, executed a purchase Contract to Software as a service for Information Technology Service Management and Enterprise Service Management software to support a citywide service management process in an amount not to exceed \$42,361.02, and an expiration date of September 14, 2027; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to the Contract will add to the scope of work and increase the contract amount by \$182,638.98, bringing the total contract amount to \$225,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This action is not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq. and the CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. §§ 15000 et. seq.), including without limitation, Public Resources Code section 21065 and California Code of Regulations 15378 as this is not a “project” that may cause a direct, or reasonably foreseeable indirect, physical change in the environment and because the action constitutes organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

2. This First Amendment to Consultant Contract between the City of Watsonville and TeamDynamix, a corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
