A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND GRIFFIN STRUCTURES, INC., A CORPORATION, ADDING TO THE SCOPE OF WORK, INCREASING CONTRACT COMPENSATION BY \$283,700; EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT TO DECEMBER 31, 2024; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2021, Council adopted Resolution No. 218-21 (CM) awarding Contract for Professional Services to Griffin Structures, Inc, for Project Management Services for the Implementation of the Ramsay Park Master Plan (Ramsay Park Improvement Project) in an amount not to exceed \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, § 3-5.170 of the Municipal Code provides that amendments to contracts that reasonably relate to the scope of the original contract, are based on post-award information that requires modification of the contract based on changes in scope and were originally approved by Council shall be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to the Contract will add to the scope of work, increase contract compensation by \$283,700.00, bringing the total contract amount to \$433,700.00 and extend the contract term from June 30, 2023 to December 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Adopting a Resolution approving First Amendment to Contract with Griffin Structures, Inc., does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

2. This First Amendment to Contract between the City of Watsonville and Griffin Structures, Inc., a corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
