SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROVING A ONE YEAR FACILITY USE

CONTRACT WITH PVUSD AT THE GHWR YOUTH CENTER TO PROVIDE PROGRAMMING TO STUDENTS OF PVUSD'S SELPA

**PROGRAM** 

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

That the Council adopt a resolution approving a one-year facility use contract with the Pájaro Valley Unified School District (PVUSD) for facility use space at the Gene Hoularis and Waldo Rodriguez (GHWR) Youth Center, located at 30 Maple Avenue, commencing on August 15, 2022 and ending on June 3, 2023, and authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute the same.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

During the 2021-2022 school year, Pajaro Valley Unified School District's Special Education Program/Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) reached out to the City of Watsonville Parks and Community Services Department for facility use for their special education class. The Department was able to accommodate their request by entering into a one-year contract with PVUSD, which allowed the SELPA program classroom use space at the GHWR Youth Center during non-program hours.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Similar to the previous school year, PVUSD Special Education Program would once again like to enter into a one-year facility use contract with the City of Watsonville Parks and Community Services Department for use of the GHWR Youth Center for their special education class as a classroom.

Use of the classroom will not interfere with the Department's recreational programming, thus the Department is able to accommodate this facility use request.

## **STRATEGIC PLAN:**

This contract supports the Strategic Plan of: 5-Community Engagement & Well-Being as this collaboration will provide a space for students with special needs.
