

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (CM)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING A ONE YEAR FACILITY USE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND PAJARO VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY LOCATED AT 30 MAPLE AVENUE, (GENE HOULARIS WALDO RODRIGUEZ YOUTH CENTER), TO PROVIDE PROGRAMMING TO STUDENTS OF PVUSD'S SELPA PROGRAM, COMMENCING ON AUGUST 15, 2022, AND ENDING JUNE 2, 2023, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), in that adopting a Resolution approving the Facility Use Contract attached hereto does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and if a "project," is exempt under the "common sense" exception (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3)) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment.

2. That the one-year Facility Use Contract between the City of Watsonville and Pajaro Valley Unified School District, for the use of City owned property located at 30 Maple Avenue, Watsonville, (GHWR Youth Center) for classroom space for SELPA students, commencing on August 15, 2022, and ending June 2, 2023, a copy of which Facility Use Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is fair and equitable and is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Facility Use Contract for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
