

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONSULTANT SERVICES CONTRACT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE
AND CSG CONSULTANTS, INC.**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT for consultant services is entered into by and between the **City of Watsonville** ("City") and **CSG Consultants, Inc.** ("Consultant") this day of _____. The City and Consultant agree as follows:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant have previously executed a Consultant Services Contract to revise for On Call Engineering Plan Check Review Services dated September 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the original contract was in the amount of \$75,000 with an expiration date of December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 7-22 (CM) approving the First Amendment to amend Section 4 and Exhibit "C", both entitled "Compensation", to provide an additional amount not to exceed \$100,000 for a new contract total amount not to exceed \$175,000; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment of the Contract for Consultant Services is in the best interest of the City of Watsonville.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the Consultant agree that the Contract shall be amended as follows:

Section 2 is hereby amended to add the following:

"Section 2. Term of Contract. The term of the Contract shall be extended to June 30, 2024."

Section 3 and Exhibit "B", both entitled "Schedule of Performance", is hereby amended to read:

"All work shall be completed by June 30, 2024."

Section 4 is hereby amended to read:

"Section 4 and Exhibit "C" both entitled "Compensation" of the Contract, are hereby amended to update the Engineering Hourly Rates for 2024, as specified in detail in Exhibit "1", entitled SECOND AMENDMENT TO COMPENSATION, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein"


All other terms and conditions of the Contract dated September 28, 2020, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

All hourly rates include overhead costs including, but not limited to, salaries, benefits, workers' compensation insurance, travel and office expenses. CSG will coordinate the pickup and return of plans between CSG and agency offices. Overtime services and services provided outside of normal business hours will be billed at 1.5x the applicable hourly rate. On July 1 of each year following the contract start year, CSG will initiate a rate increase based on change in CPI for the applicable region. CSG will mail/email an invoice every month for services rendered during the previous month.
