**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
WATSONVILLE APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND
CALLING FOR BIDS FOR THE OHLONE PARKWAY STREET
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

WHEREAS the existing pavement along Ohlone Parkway between Harkins
Slough Rd and West Beach Street requires maintenance; and

WHEREAS the plans and specifications for the Ohlone Parkway Street
Improvements Project have been prepared; and

WHEREAS to provide for necessary street improvements, a call for bids for the
above-named project is needed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The project is determined to be categorically exempt from the requirements
of CEQA in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, CE Class 1, in that the
project involves maintenance of an existing street which does not create additional
automobile lanes; and there are no existing unusual circumstances related to the project
that would cause a significant effect on the environment as defined in CEQA Guidelines
Section 15382.

2. That the plans and specifications for the Ohlone Parkway Street
Improvements Project copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk and
incorporated by reference in this Resolution, are hereby approved.

3. That the Purchasing Officer is hereby authorized and directed to call for
public competitive sealed bids in accordance with Title 7, Chapter 14 of the Watsonville

Municipal Code for the above named project, and that the bids are to be tentatively opened in the “Old City Council Chambers”, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, on March 21, 2024, at 11:00 A.M., and the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice inviting such sealed bids in the time, form, and manner provided by law.

4. That hand-carried bids should be delivered to the City of Watsonville, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, c/o Purchasing Officer. Bidders may mail bids at their own risk to the City of Watsonville, c/o Purchasing Officer, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California 95076.

5. That after the bids are opened, they shall be tabulated and analyzed and a report submitted to the City Manager, who shall recommend the awarding, or other action, to the Council at its next regular meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible.
