A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE DECLARING CITY OF WATSONVILLE CLEANUP DAY THE SECOND SATURDAY OF MAY OF EACH YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Watsonville is renowned for its natural beauty and unique wetland habitat; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City and County have long been dedicated to protecting the beauty of our natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Watsonville has been a leader in environmental protection and policies that reduce waste and help keep litter from impacting the local environment; and

WHEREAS, the City, in partnership with Pitch-In Santa Cruz County, has participated in organized community clean-ups, volunteer engagement, and partnerships with other local governments in a citizen-led effort to protect the City's natural spaces from litter; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that a countywide cleanup day is an effective way to engage the community in cleaning up litter from parks, streets, wetlands, beaches, and other public spaces to improve the overall cleanliness of the City, and encourage residents of all ages, businesses, and community organizations to participate in the Countywide Cleanup Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:
