




- These needles could be picked up by kids walking by on Airport Blvd








On going Construction


- New Buildings are being erected as we speak

Chronological List of Events

- Case initiated on July 3, 2023. Notice of Violation issued to owner of record.
- July 6, 2023, Code Enforcement Staff met with Karam Singh VP of KDS Dhaliwal (owner).
- July 20, 2023, follow up inspection, encampment visually bigger

Chronological List of Events Continued

- July 31, 2023, A follow up Inspection, encampment larger more tents, and trash.
- August 2, 2023, Mr. Karam Singh and his designer met with Planning and Code Enforcement Personnel
- Code Enforcement conducted many more site visit.
- March 11, 2024, A call to Mr. Singh to try to avoid abatement process.

At this time, we are requesting that the City Council directs/authorizes the building official to Abate the Nuisance at this vacant lot (APN: 014-021-01) without delay.
