**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND TRAFFIC PATTERNS, LLC., A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, FOR THE ON CALL TRAFFIC SERVICES FOR DESIGN REVIEW, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING STUDIES, TRAFFIC ANALYSIS REVIEW, PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT SITE PLAN REVIEW AND OFF SITE IMPROVEMENT CONCEPT PLANS, INCREASING COMPENSATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$95,000, FOR A REVISED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$285,000; EXTENDING THE CONTRACT TERM TO JUNE 30, 2025; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, on December 22, 2021, the City executed a contract with Traffic Patterns, LLC., a limited liability company, for the On-Call Traffic Services for Design Review, Traffic Engineering Studies, Traffic Analysis Review, Private Development Site Plan Review and Off-Site Improvement Concept Plans, in an amount not to exceed \$95,000; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 27, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 27-24 (CM), approving the First Amendment to Contract, increasing the contract compensation in the amount of \$95,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$190,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this Second Amendment to Contract will increase compensation by \$95,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$285,000, and extend the contract term from June 30, 2024 to June 30, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funding is needed to ensure that the on-call traffic services for design review, traffic engineering studies, traffic analysis review, private development site plan review and off-site improvement concept plans can continue for the remainder of the term of the contract and assist with filling the city's vacant Traffic Operations Manager position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Adopting a Resolution approving a Second Amendment to Contract with Traffic Patterns, LLC., does not meet CEQA’s definition of a “project”, because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

2. The Second Amendment to the Contract between the City of Watsonville and Traffic Patterns, LLC., a limited liability company, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.

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
