ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE HARKINS SLOUGH ROAD  
OVERPASS SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN RELOCATION  
PROJECT, NO. ST-23-14859SS

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## **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council approve plans and specifications and call for bids for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Plans and specifications have been prepared for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation and the project is ready to be bid.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The City is working in collaboration with Caltrans to install a pedestrian bridge extension to improve pedestrian safety across the Harkins Slough Road Highway 1 overpass. During the design it was identified that the proposed location of the overpass bridge piers would conflict with the existing sanitary sewer force main installation under the highway. Wallace Group was selected to perform a detailed design to relocate the existing sanitary sewer force main from under the freeway to an existing utility encasement through the existing highway overpass box girder. Completion of this utility relocation project is necessary in order for construction of the pedestrian bridge to begin.

The plans and specifications have been prepared and the project is ready to be advertised for bid. Bid opening is tentatively scheduled for August 15, 2024, at 2:00 PM. The plans and specifications are on file in the City Clerk's Office, and the engineer's estimate is \$584,000.

The project qualifies as Categorical Exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 CE Class 1, minor

alteration of existing public facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond existing.
