WHEREAS, on April 25, 2024, the City executed a contract with Wallace Group, a California Corporation, for the engineering design services for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project; and

WHEREAS, the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS design has been completed and the project is ready for advertisement to bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 Categorical Exemption Class 1, in that adding a pressure reducing valve station to an existing water distribution system is a minor alteration of an existing public facility involving negligible or no expansion of use.
- 2. That the plans and specifications for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk and incorporated by reference in this Resolution, are hereby approved.
- 3. That the Purchasing Officer is hereby authorized and directed to call for public competitive sealed bids in accordance with Title 7, Chapter 14 of the Watsonville Municipal Code for the above named project, and that the bids are to be opened in the
