SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER A CONTRACT WITH ARAMARK

UNIFORM SERVICES, A DIVISION OF ARAMARK UNIFORM & CAREER APPAREL GROUP, INC. FOR A NOT TO EXCEED

AMOUNT OF \$145,765.62

STATEMENT OF ISSUES:

City staff requires uniform and laundry services which are utilized by various departments in the performance of their duties.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution awarding a three-year contract to Aramark Uniform Services, a division of Aramark Uniform & Career Apparel Group, Inc. for uniform and laundry services, in an amount not to exceed the amount of \$145,765.62 for three years; authorizing a 10% contingency for unforeseen circumstances; and authorizing the City Manager Pro Tempore to execute the Contract.

DISCUSSION:

BUILDING

The uniform and laundry services provided by Aramark Uniform Services are an essential part of employee safety as they provide the required apparel necessary for work in accordance with the needs of different departments. The services provided will ensure our employees have access to a steady supply of regularly laundered garments available for their required use while at work. Aramark will provide services that include towels, floor mats and, jackets, vests, pants, and shirts to over 100 employees.
