A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH VERDE DESIGN, INC., A CORPORATION, FOR LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES AND CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR RAMSAY PARK IMPROVEMENTS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,016,786; AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2021, City Council adopted Resolution No. 194-21 (CM) awarding a consultant contract to Verde Design, Inc. for landscape architectural design and consultant services for the Ramsay Park Improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$1,553,182 with a completion date of June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, § 3-5.170 of the Municipal Code provides that amendments to contracts that reasonably relate to the scope of the original contract and were originally approved by Council shall be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to Contract will increase the scope of services due to additional environmental monitoring, construction support, and design services needed; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to Contract will modify the schedule of performance to June 30, 2026, and increase the contract amount by \$463,604 not to exceed \$2,016,786.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Adopting a Resolution approving a contract amendment to a consultant agreement does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project", because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

2. This first amendment to contract between the City of Watsonville and Verde Design, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said first amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
