**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING THIRD AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., A CORPORATION, FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENT PREPARATION SERVICES FOR THE HIGHWAY 1 AND HARKINS SLOUGH ROAD PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AMENDING THE CONTRACT COMPENSATION AND ADDING \$30,000; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, on September 17, 2021, the City executed a Consultant Services Contract to provide Design and Construction Document Preparation Services for the Highway 1 and Harkins Slough Rd Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Improvements Project, in an amount not to exceed \$90,020; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 31, 2023, the City executed the First Amendment to Contract, and extending the term of the contract to June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 7, 2024, the City executed the Second Amendment to Contract, and extending the term of the contract to June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Third Amendment to Contract will increase the contract compensation by \$30,000 for a contract total amount of \$120,020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), in that adopting a Resolution awarding contract to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., a corporation, for design and construction document preparation services for the Highway 1 and Harkins Slough Rd Pedestrian Bridge and Safe Routes to School Improvements Project does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have

the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and if a “project,” is exempt under the “common sense” exception (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3)) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this action may have a significant effect on the environment.

2. This Third Amendment to Contract between the City of Watsonville and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., a corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Third Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and City Attorney.

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
