A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND MNS ENGINEERS, INC., A CORPORATION, FOR DESIGN SERVICES THROUGH CONSTRUCTION FOR THE WWTF ELECTRICAL SYSTEM HAZARD MITIGATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, NO WW-22-14797, AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK, ADDING TO THE COMPENSATION AMOUNT BY \$175,534 AND EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT FROM JANUARY 31, 2025 TO DECEMBER 31, 2027; AND DIRECTING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 40-22 (CM) approving a Contract for Consultant Services with MNS Engineers, Inc., a corporation, for design services for the Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) Electrical System Hazard Mitigation Improvements Project No. WW-22-14797; and

WHEREAS, the original contract not to exceed amount was \$354,345 with an expiration date of January 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, § 3-5.170 of the Municipal Code provides that amendments to contracts that reasonably relate to the scope of the original contact, are based on post-award information that requires modifications of the contract based on unforeseen conditions and were originally approved by Council shall be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to Contract will add to the scope of work, and increase the contract amount by \$175,534, for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$529,879 and extend the term of completion to December 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, no CEQA action is required with the approval of this item as the project's Notice of Exemption was recorded with the Santa Cruz County Clerk of the Board on July 17, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the First Amendment to Contract between the City of Watsonville and MNS Engineers, Inc., a corporation, a copy of which First Amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved.

2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville, with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
