SUBJECT: RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE HARKINS
SLOUGH ROAD OVERPASS SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN
RELOCATION PROJECT, NO. ST-23-14859SS

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Adopt a resolution rejecting all bids for the plans and specifications for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS.

BACKGROUND:

The Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS was bid and the results received, requiring action from City Council.

DISCUSSION:

At the July 9, 2024 meeting, Council adopted Resolution No. 135-24 (CM) approving the plans and specifications and calling for bids for the Harkins Slough Road Overpass Sanitary Sewer Force Main Relocation Project, No. ST-23-14859SS.

Bids were opened on November 26, 2024 at 3:30pm. The bid results are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Total
CEAU	\$795,112.81

Engineer's estimate was \$697,284 which included a 20% contingency. The only bid received was 14% higher than this estimate, which is outside the planned budget available for the project.

Staff therefore recommends that all bids be rejected. Rather than rebidding the sewer relocation project as a separate project again. Given the schedule of the bridge project and the coordination that will be required with its installation contractor, there is not sufficient time available to rebid and complete sewer relocation ahead of the bridge project construction. Staff therefore plans instead to incorporate this project's design into

the larger Harkins Slough pedestrian bridge improvements project which is anticipated to be bid in spring 2025.
