SUBJECT: NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Receive an update on the implementation of the City's Neighborhood Traffic Management Plan and traffic calming activities.

DISCUSSION:

In 2023, at the direction of the Council, staff reviewed and adjusted the process for addressing neighborhood traffic concerns. The revised process was incorporated into a Neighborhood Traffic Management Plan and presented to the Council as a report at their October 24, 2023, meeting.

The Plan called for a three-phase approach to traffic concerns:

- Phase 1 included a preliminary investigation and assessment by City staff and implementation of Fast Action Engineering Improvements that could be done by City staff within six months.
- Phase 2 included projects that required data collection and analysis and could impact neighborhoods. After data collection and analysis, staff will meet with the community to discuss possible impacts before implementation. These would be minor projects with minor costs.
- Phase 3 included projects with greater impacts on neighborhoods and greater costs. These major projects could involve determining whether a majority of the neighbors supported them, securing funding, and inclusion in the City's Capital Improvement Program.

The Plan called for creating a Traffic Advisory Committee, which has met three times.

Staff will provide a report on the implementation of the Plan.
