SUBJECT: APPROVE FREEWAY MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH
CALTRANS FOR MAINTENANCE OF HARKINS SLOUGH RD
OVERCROSSING AT HIGHWAY 1

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends that Council adopt a resolution approving a Freeway Maintenance Agreement with Caltrans for maintenance of roadway improvements at Harkins Slough Rd. overcrossing at Highway 1.

BACKGROUND:

On June 4, 1965, the City and the State (Caltrans) executed a Freeway Maintenance Agreement, wherein the parties consented to certain adjustments of the local street and road system required for the development of a certain portion of Highway 1, declared a freeway. On October 3, 1967, the City and the State executed a Freeway Maintenance Agreement whereby the parties clarified the division of maintenance responsibility as to separation structures and city streets and landscaped areas. This Freeway Maintenance Agreement does not replace or supersede the agreements mentioned, but updates the responsibilities to reflect the proposed overpass widening project.

DISCUSSION:

Through the Freeway Maintenance Agreement, the State and City clarify the division of maintenance at the interface between the State highway right-of-way and City right-of-way.
