

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (CM)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING CHANGE ORDER WITH DURAMAX HOLDINGS LLC DBA OTTO ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS, FOR RESIDENTIAL REFUSE AND RECYCLING ROLL-OUT CARTS, ADDING \$4,000 FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE ORDER AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$167,260; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 218-24 (CM) authorizing a sole source purchase from Duramax Holdings LLC dba Otto Environmental Systems, for residential refuse and recycling roll-out carts, in an amount not to exceed \$163,260; and

WHEREAS, a change order is needed to add \$4,000 to the purchase order, due to the freight costs being higher than estimated on the original quote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. No additional California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review is required for the purchase order change order for Residential Refuse and Recycling Roll-Carts from Duramax Holdings LLC dba Otto Environmental Systems. On October 22, 2024, the City Council declared the purchase of Residential Refuse and Recycling Roll-Out Carts as exempt in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378 (b)(5), as it does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project". Further, the approval of the purchase order change order for Residential Refuse and Recycle Roll-Out Carts is an administrative activity that would have not the potential to either (1) cause a direct physical change in the environment, or (2) cause a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Therefore, no CEQA action is required at this time.

2. The Council hereby authorizes the change order with Duramax Holdings LLC dba Otto Environmental Systems, adding \$4,000 for a total purchase order amount not to exceed \$167,260, for the purchase of Residential Refuse and Recycling Roll-Out Carts.
