- WHEREAS,** Greg's commitment to public service is further exemplified through his active involvement in organizations such as the Penny Club, Knights of Columbus, American Legion, Lions Club, and Little League baseball, where he has worked to strengthen community ties and foster civic engagement among residents.

- WHEREAS,** Mark is a second generation Watsonville native with Croatian and Portuguese roots; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark attended Watsonville High School, where he played football at the quarterback position, was a pole vault record holder in 1975, and graduated 5th in his class; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder with a Bachelor in Science Small Business Administration degree in 1979; and
- WHEREAS,** he started his career at Sambrailo Paper Co., founded by his Croatian grandfather Charles P. Sambrailo Sr., in 1981; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark helped develop the clamshell with his father, William K. Sambrailo, positioned the company as the first to label field-ready clamshells for customers and suppliers, designed the current raspberry clamshell tray, and also designed two tabbed half-size trays to hold six pints of fruit; and
- WHEREAS,** in 1996, Mark became President of the company and has since increased its size five-fold, including opening a Mexican packaging company, SambraMex, in 2001; and
- WHEREAS,** in 2000, Mark developed and patented the MIXIM Packaging System, giving cooling and freight efficiencies; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark also developed the first four pound strawberry clamshell that gave 30% freight efficiency to Costco and California berry shippers and started the ReadyCycle basket program among many other accomplishments; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark served on the Board of Directors of Watsonville Community Hospital and educational non-profit Agri-Culture, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark was involved in the creation of St. Francis High School in 2001, coached various sports at local school for many years, and makes donations to various programs throughout the year; and
- WHEREAS,** Mark enjoys spending time with his wife, three children, and five grandchildren, the third and fourth generations with roots in Watsonville.
