A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE CONSIDERING ALL BIDS NON-RESPONSIVE FOR THE MILES LANE SEWER PUMP STATION REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. SS-22-14798; AND AUTHORIZING REBID OF THE PROJECT WITHOUT THE PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT AS MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE CITY AND MONTEREY/SANTA CRUZ BUILDING & CONTRUCTION TRADES COUNCIL

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 161-22 (CM) approving plans and specifications and authorized calling for bids for the Miles Lane Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, the bids for the Project, were publicly opened in the “Old City Council Chambers”, City Hall, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, CA on October 6, 2022, at 2:00PM, and no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, the Project was rebid and bids were publicly opened electronically through the City’s online procurement portal (OpenGov) on February 4, 2025, at 3:00PM; and

WHEREAS, staff determined both bids to be non-responsive due to not meeting the experience requirements in the bid form; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended that all bids be considered non-responsive pursuant to section 7-14.09 of the Watsonville Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Miles Lane Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation Project SS-22-14798 is Categorically Exempt under Guidelines Section 15302 (c), Class 2, replacement or reconstruction, because the project involves the replacement or reconstruction of existing utility system facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity; and none of the

exceptions identified in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 have been determined to apply, specifically, no unusual circumstances related to the project existing that would cause significant effect on the environment as defined in CEQA Guidelines Section 15382.

2. That all bids for the Miles Lane Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation Project are non-responsive and therefore rejected.

3. That rebid of the project without the City's standard Project Labor Agreement as mutually agreed upon by the MSCBT Council and the City is authorized.
