SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROVING THIRD AMENDMENT TO SITE SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH PAJARO VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution approving Third Amendment to Site Services Agreement between the City of Watsonville and the Pajaro Valley Unified School District, for the provision of services through the District's Expanded Learning Opportunities Program to extend the term of the contract through August 15, 2025, and direct the City Manager to execute the same.

BACKGROUND:

On September 13, 2022, the City Council approved Resolution No. 190-22 for approval of a Site Service Agreement/Short Term Agreement between the City of Watsonville and Pajaro Valley Unified School District to provide before-school programming through the District's ELOP Program. During that same meeting, the City approved and adopted Resolution 191-22, the First Amendment of the Site Services Agreement/Short-Term Agreement to add to the scope of work, increase compensation to \$278,000, and extend the term of the contract to June 30, 2023.

On January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 13-23, approving the Second Amendment of the contract for provision of services through the District's Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP), in an amount not to exceed \$2,200,000 from June 30, 2023, through June 30, 2025.

DISCUSSION:

The term of the agreement with Pajaro Valley Unified School District ends on June 30, 2025.

Both parties would like to continue with the scope of services through the duration of summer programming. The proposed amendment:

- Extends the term of existing agreement through August 15, 2025, to ensure services continue throughout the summer and until the new school year begins and a new contract for new school year is in place.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) DETERMINATION:

This action does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project" because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

Community Engagement & Well-being - This collaboration continues to support the Strategic Goal by leveraging resources and strengthening community partnerships through youth programs that build developmental assets and improve the quality of life.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All costs associated with these services will continue to be paid by PVUSD. This amendment will have no impact on the current budgeted contract amount.

ALTERNATIVE ACTION:

The Council could not approve this Resolution and programming services would cease effective July 1, 2025.
