Fencing is underway at River Park and Bay Breeze.

At Callaghan Park, pickleball court fencing is done—surfacing starts next, with an opening expected next month (weather permitting).

Pinto has new bleachers, Franich has new bollards, and upgraded irrigation controllers are saving water across several parks.
