## Background

- Applications were due April 23, 2025
- 31 applications were received
  - 16 organizations reapplied for continued funding
  - 15 new organizations applied for funding
- Total funding requested was \$599,850
- Total funding available \$235,000



#### Funding Guidelines

- The subcommittee established an annual funding range of \$6,000 to \$24,000 per organization
- The subcommittee also recommended setting funding aside for community projects at a range of \$1,000 per project – No applications were received for this purpose.
- Funding recommendations also include capacity to support community special events which helps various non-profit agencies cover the fees and costs associated with hosting special events. Based on the following criteria:
  - Tier I Maximum of 50% of City fees or \$10,000, whichever is higher
  - Tier II Maximum of 50% of City fees or \$4,000, whichever is higher
  - Tier III Maximum of 50% of City fees or \$1,500, whichever is higher
  - Tier IV Maximum of 50% of City fees or \$750, whichever is higher
