A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT WITH K&D LANDSCAPING, INC. FOR THE 2023-2026 LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE PARKS AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AMENDING SCOPE OF SERVICES AND INCREASING COMPENSATION, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$50,284 FOR A REVISED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$273,342 PER YEAR; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2023, City Council adopted Resolution 235-23 (CM) awarding a consultant contract to K&D Landscaping, Inc. for landscape services for the City, in an annual amount not to exceed \$223,058 with a completion date of December 31, 2026, and with the option to extend an additional two-year term; and

WHEREAS, § 3-5.170 of the Municipal Code provides that amendments to contracts that reasonably relate to the scope of the original contract and were originally approved by Council shall be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to Contract will add to the scope of services to include additional areas needing landscape services at an annual cost of \$50,284, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$273,342 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Landscape maintenance is exempt from CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15304(a), as it is a minor alteration to land, and 15301(c) as it is a repair to existing facilities. This amendment to the original contract for landscape services does not create any new impacts that have not been previously considered.

2. This first amendment to contract between the City of Watsonville and K&D Landscaping, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said first amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
