**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND PANTHER PROTECTIVE SERVICES, INC., INCREASING THE CONTRACT TOTAL BY \$76,205 FOR A REVISED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000 AND EXTENDING THE TERM TO JUNE 30, 2027 FOR SECURITY SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, on November 3, 2023, the City Manager awarded contract to Panther Protective Services, Inc., for security services at both City parking garages, in an amount not to exceed \$73,755; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 30, 2025, the contract for consultant services between the City of Watsonville and Panther Protective Services, Inc. expired; and

**WHEREAS**, Panther Protective Services, Inc. has continued to provide security services as per the terms of the contract while an amendment was being prepared; and

**WHEREAS**, this First Amendment to the Contract will increase the contract total by \$76,205, bringing the total revised contract amount not to exceed \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this First Amendment will extend the term of the contract to June 30, 2027.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), in that adopting a Resolution approving a First Amendment to Contract with Panther Protective Services, does not meet CEQA's definition of a "project," because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

2. That the First Amendment to Contract between the City of Watsonville and Panther Protective Services, Inc., for security services, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

3. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville, with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
