A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AND J. JOHNSON & COMPANY, INC., A CORPORATION, FOR THE 2024-2025 CITYWIDE SIDEWALK REPAIR PROJECT, ADDING TO THE SCOPE OF WORK, INCREASING THE COMPENSATION BY \$166,000, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2025, Council adopted Resolution No. 33-25 (CM), authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with J. Johnson & Company, Inc., a corporation for the 2024-2025 Citywide Sidewalk Repair Project in an amount not to exceed \$229,550; and

WHEREAS, this Contract Change Order No. 1 will add to the scope of work and increase the contract by \$166,000, for a total revised contract amount not to exceed \$395,550.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. On February 11, 2025, the City Council declared the 2024-2025 Citywide Sidewalk Project as categorically exempt in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301, CE Class 1, maintenance of existing streets involving no expansion of capacity, and no changes to the project are proposed that would result in an environmental impact and thus no additional environmental review is required for the 2024-2025 Citywide Sidewalk Project.

2. That the Contract Change Order No. 1 between the City of Watsonville and J. Johnson & Company, Inc. a copy of which, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved.

3. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute said Contract Change Order No. 1 for and on behalf of the City of Watsonville with minor revisions that may be approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.
