A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND CALLING FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BIORETENTION PONDS AND EMERGENCY VEHICLE ACCESS ROAD IN THE SUNSHINE GARDEN DEVELOPMENT, PROJECT NO. ST-21-01873241 (ESTIMATED COST OF \$750,000 WILL BE PAID FROM MONIES FROM THE SECURITY FOR THE SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT)

WHEREAS, the Sunshine Garden Subdivision, Tract 1587 located near 1773

Santa Victoria Avenue was started by the owner but not completed; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Utilities Department will now oversee this necessary construction.

- 1. That the plans and specifications for construction of bioretention ponds and emergency vehicle access road in the Sunshine Garden Subdivision, Tract 1587, Project No. ST-21-01873241, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, are hereby ratified and approved.
- 2. That the Purchasing Officer is hereby authorized and directed to call for public competitive sealed bids for the above named project, and that the bids are to be opened in the "Old City Council Chambers," 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, on Tuesday, August 10, 2021, at 11:00 A.M., and the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice inviting such sealed bids in the time, form, and manner provided by law.
- 3. That hand-carried bids should be delivered to the City of Watsonville, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California, c/o Purchasing Officer. Bidders may mail bids at their own risk to the City of Watsonville, c/o Purchasing Officer, 250 Main Street, Watsonville, California 95076.

4. That after the bids are opened, they shall be tabulated and analyzed and a report submitted to the City Manager, who shall recommend the awarding, or other action, to the Council at its next regular meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible.
