SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$7,000 GRANT
FROM PACIFIC LIBRARY PARTNERSHIP

STATEMENT OF ISSUES:

Resolution accepting and appropriating \$7,000 from Pacific Library Partnership to support pop-up library programming utilizing the Library's BiblioVan.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the City Council accept a grant for \$7,000 from Pacific Library Partnership. This grant will provide funds to support pop-up library programming at 9 (nine) summer meal partner community sites.

DISCUSSION:

The Watsonville Public Library was awarded a \$7,000 grant from Pacific Library Partnership to partner with a community organization that offers meals during the summer. The Library partnered with Community Bridges to provide pop-up library programming at 9 (nine) community meal sites.

The goal of *Lunch with the Library* is to connect with youth ages 0-18, promote library resources and services, and ensure that all youth at each site receive a free book!

The awarded funds will be used for the purposes as indicated in the "Library Proposed Spending Budget":

1. \$1,500 of the funding will be utilized for staff salary time and backfill, which includes Librarian, Senior Library Assistant, Library Assistant and Library Clerk wages.
2. \$1,500 of the funding will be utilized for purchase of a custom shade tent and two table cloths. Items will be used to increase library visibility at community outreach programs.
3. \$4,000 of the funding will be utilized to purchase English, Spanish and Bilingual giveaway books.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

This grant supports the Strategic Plan: 05-Community Engagement & Well-Being – Library Services & Programs.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The grant from Pacific Library Partnership will be awarded in one payment and will go directly towards staffing costs, and purchasing outreach and giveaway materials to support pop-up library programming.

ALTERNATIVE ACTION:

If this grant is not accepted, the library will need to find alternative funding sources to complete the implementation of this program.
