**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE TO ACCEPT THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,767 TO FUND CRIME ANALYSIS SOFTWARE, TO EXECUTE A STANDARD AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AND APPROPRIATING SUCH FUNDS TO THE JAG ACCOUNT**

**WHEREAS**, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS**, cities funded by the JAG Program are eligible to receive funding for specific purpose areas such as: law enforcement programs, prosecution and court programs, including indigent defense, prevention and education programs, corrections and community corrections programs, drug treatment and enforcement programs, planning, evaluation and technology improvement programs, and crime victim and witness programs (other than compensation); and

**WHEREAS**, the grant to be accepted is to fund crime analysis software; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Watsonville, a municipal corporation of the State of California, wishes to accept for FY 2021 the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, in the amount of \$21,767.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the City Manager of the City of Watsonville, on behalf of the City of Watsonville, is authorized and directed to accept the United States Department of

Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for FY 2021, in the amount of \$21,767 to fund crime analysis software.

2. That the City Manager of the City of Watsonville, is authorized and directed to execute in the name of the City of Watsonville, all documents required by the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the JAG Program, and any amendments thereto, as well as any necessary documents.

3. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to appropriate the \$21,767 to the JAG account.
